

## What to Bring to the Hospital

### For Labor:

- Lip balm
- Extra pillows (your own may be more comfortable)
- Object for focal point
- Music/movies
- List of names and phone numbers, cell phone charger

### After Delivery:

- Pajamas and bathrobe (if you prefer your own)
- Slippers
- Nursing Bra (if breast feeding)
- Toiletries (shampoo, conditioner, toothbrush, toothpaste, brush/comb, etc.) if you prefer your own or they can be provided
- Loose/comfortable clothing to wear home (about what you were wearing at 6 months pregnant)

### For Baby:

- Baby book
- Outfit for going home
- Blanket and outer wear for going home
- Car seat-rear facing is required for infants under one year of age.
