What is Nitrous Oxide?

Nitrous Oxide, or "laughing gas," is an inhaled gas used to relieve pain in labor and/or during procedures after delivery. It is an almost odorless, tasteless gas that enters and exits the body quickly during use.

How is it used?

Nitrous Oxide is breathed in through a mask that you will hold over your mouth and nose during a contraction. You control the amount of gas you give yourself.

Benefits

- Helps you relax and feel less tense during contractions.
- Works quickly
- Does not slow down labor
- You do not need an IV
- You do not need to be attached to a baby monitor all of the time
- There is no effect on the baby
- May be used if you need a procedure after the baby is born

Possible Side Effects

- Nausea or vomiting
- Feeling dizzy or lightheaded
- · Feeling restless, anxious, or nervous

Please consult your physician before deciding if nitrous oxide is the right choice for you.
